Lakehouse Waiver

Lakehouse

Your key card will let you into the building from 5:30 am-10 pm. Please keep in mind that the card system is set by a timer. The building alarm will go off if anyone is in the building after 10pm. If your card is lost or stolen please report it immediately. When you access the building you are on video surveillance.

Each family will have received two access cards for individuals 18 and over. If youth enter the facility using the access card then the card will be denied for the entire family. Additional cards and lost cards may be purchased for \$25 each. Individuals under the age of 18 will receive a program card.

Children must be at least 14 years old to be in the fitness center and must go through an orientation. Orientations for individuals 18 and older are optional but recommended. Youth under the age of 10 are not allowed in the building without a parent.

Pool

The pool will be open from 10am-8pm most days Memorial Day to Labor Day. The pool will only be open when a certified lifeguard is on duty. Check the calendar for the exact schedule.

An individual (nanny) 16 or older must accompany a child 10 or younger in the pool area. Children 11 and over can be in the pool area if they have passed the swim test and we have the release form for minor's use of recreation amenities. Any child that does not pass the swim test must have a parent within arms reach of them while in the water. The nanny must be registered and have their card, and we must have the release for minor's form if the nanny is between 16-18.

Boathouse

Must be 12 or older in order to use a boat without parental supervision. If under 16 you must complete an orientation with a parent present and be on the approved swim test list. If under 18 you must have a parent or guardian sign a Boathouse waiver and must wear a lifejacket at all times. (Over the age of 18 you must have a lifejacket available for every person in the boat.)

Waiver (A waiver must be signed for each member)

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the YMCA, its directors, officers, employees, and agents (hereinafter referred to as “releases”) from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise while the undersigned is in, upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein, or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA, without respect to location.

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in, upon, or about the YMCA premises or in any way observing or using any facilities or equipment of the YMCA or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to negligence of releases or otherwise while in, about, or upon the premises of the YMCA or Southshore Master Association and/or while using the premises or any facilities or equipment thereon or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA. The undersigned understands there is not a certified lifeguard on duty while I am using the boathouse.

THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the forgoing RELEASE, WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Colorado and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements, or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

Release Form for Minor's Use of Recreation Amenities

It is agreed and understood that Minor's unsupervised use of the above indicated use of the Recreation Amenities may be revoked at any time by the Southshore Manager in the event that said minor disregards or otherwise violates any Southshore Master Association Rules and Regulations, policies or otherwise engages in conduct inappropriate for use of the Recreation Amenities.
